David serves as the Executive Director and an On-Air Personality with Praise Live, which he joined in 1985. Discussion Questions

1. The premise of David's popular book, *Looking For The One*, is that all believers whose lives have been touched and transformed by the Lord have the opportunity to share Him with someone, or even several people, throughout the day or week. All we have to do is ask Him to help us be attuned to who that person might be, and to follow His leading in our conversations with them. He handles the rest, since He is the One searching for the lost through us.

Question: Up until now, has this idea ever occurred to you? Don't be surprised or too hard on yourself if it hasn't. It hasn't for many committed believers. Now that the idea has been presented, would you like to begin putting in into practice now?

Question: Perhaps you have examples in your faith walk of when you specifically asked the Lord to bring someone into your life that day, with whom to share His love and message of hope. If so, can you share the story one of those memorable divine appointments?

2. The Chick-Fil-A training video powerfully depicts the backstories of customers and servers in one of their restaurants. Things we would never know about these strangers but, if we did, might change our view of them and heart toward them.

Question: How might that video change your view of perfect strangers and, perhaps, your openness toward engaging them in a gentle and loving way which could potentially become just the touch from the Lord they need at that time?
